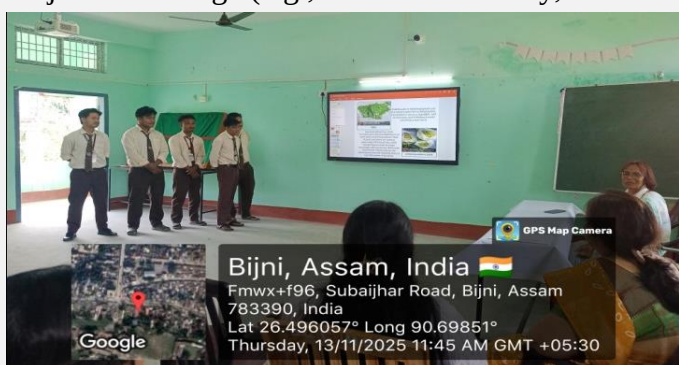
Wall magazine

Other caves are smaller in sizes but similar in architectural style.
