## **ELECTION GUIDELINES**

## ELECTION TO THE BCSU 2022-23 Bijni College, Bijni.



- **1.** The candidates shall be a regular and <u>fulltime student</u> of the college in a full-time course. The course duration shall have to be minimum one year.
- 2. The candidate shall have <u>one opportunity to contest</u> for the post of office bearers and two opportunities to contest for the post of an executive member.
- 3. The <u>proposers and the supporters</u> for any portfolio should be a <u>regular voter</u>.
- 4. Candidature shall forfeit itself if any <u>criminal case</u> is found registered against him/her or having any misdemeanor. The candidates also should not have been subject to any disciplinary action by the college or university concerned.
- 5. No candidate shall indulge in any activity that creates or causes tension between caste, community, religion and Linguistic areas. Any complaint against one involved in the said areas shall automatically forfeit his/her candidature.
- **6.** <u>No outsiders are allowed</u> to involve inside the College campus in relation to election once nomination papers are issued.
- 7. Students between the <u>age 17 and 22 years</u> are eligible for contesting the election except the class representatives for H.S. Classes (age would be calculated with reference to the date of the first election <u>notification i.e. 27-09-2022</u>)
- **8.** Candidates, supporters and proposers shall ensure that <u>names, class, Roll nos. and photo</u> in the voters list match with their College Identity cards.
- Voters of H.S. classes can only contest and be the proposer and supporter of H.S class representatives.
- 10. If <u>spelling mistake</u> is there in the name, the voter shall be an eligible voter subject to the consideration of the **presiding officer**.
- 11. No one will be eligible to vote without identity card.
- 12. If the name/surname in the Final voter list is completely different from the identity card of the voter, he/she shall **not be eligible for voting.**

- 13. No mobile phone shall be allowed within the college campus on the date of Election (i.e.28. 10. 2022)
- 14. No one without full uniform shall be allowed to enter the College campus on the date of Election (i.e. 28. 10. 2022)
- 15. If any voter violets election rules and regulations, he/she shall be subject to punishment as per the constitution of the B.C.S.U. Election.
- 16. If dummy ballot paper is detected in custody of any voter during voting hours, he/she shall be subject to punishment as per the guidelines in the constitution.
- 17. Voters will have to give "X" (Cross) mark (using black or blue ball point pen) against the candidates to cast vote.
- 18. Nomination Paper will be issued online on 15-10-2022 (10 AM) & 16 10. 2022 (12 Midnight) in Bijni College website (www.bijnicollege.ac.in).
- 19. Nomination paper submission guideline:
  - a) The contesting candidate, his/ her proposer and supporter must be a voter.
  - b) Contesting candidate must submit any one of the following particulars along with the nomination paper
    - i. Self-attested distinct photocopy of HSLC Admit card.
    - ii. Self-attested distinct photocopy of recent Identity card issued by the college authority.
  - c) Proposer and Supporter must submit their recent Identity card along with the nomination paper.
  - d) The **Undertaking form** must be attached with the nomination paper.
  - e) A proposer or a supporter cannot be the same for more than one candidate.
  - f) NB: For any other references the constitution of Bijni College will be the Ultimate referral.
