


Figure 1: Students feedback analysis (2018-2019).




Figure 2: Students feedback analysis (2018-2019).




Figure 3: Students feedback analysis (2018-2019).




Figure 4: Teachers feedback analysis (2018-2019)




Figure 5: Teachers feedback analysis (2018-2019)




Figure 6: Alumni feedback analysis (2018-2019)




Figure 1: Students feedback analysis (2019-2020).




Figure 2: Students feedback analysis (2019-2020).




Figure 3: Students feedback analysis (2019-2020).




Figure 4: Teachers feedback analysis (2019-2020)




Figure 6: Alumni feedback analysis (2019-2020)
