

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS BIJNI COLLEGE::BIJNI

Maintenance of Discipline

The college places a strong emphasis on maintaining discipline in the campus. Special attention is given to foster ethical conduct among students. All students are expected to uphold a high standard of discipline and decorum. Compliance with the rules and regulations of the institution is mandatory. Violation of these rules may face termination of scholarships, forced transfer or even expulsion from the college. Strict action will also be taken against any student found to be involved either directly or indirectly in ragging or any form of anti-social activity.

The following code of conduct is highly expected to be followed by the students:

1. Academic Ethics

- a. Students shall dress neatly and decently the prescribed dress code of the institution.
- b. For identification purpose, each student is mandatorily responsible for the use of identity card in the Institute premises and in any other academic activity or event participation representing the college outside the campus.
- c. Students are expected to maintain a minimum 75% of attendance as per the guidelines of affiliated Bodoland University.
- d. Compulsory participation in academic and co-curricular extension activities is expected.
- e. Unnecessary use of mobile phone in class hour is restricted.
- f. Ethical behaviour between fellow students, authority, teachers and office staff is expected.
- g. Use of unfair means during examination is strictly prohibited.
- h. Entry with mobile phone in the institution premise during examination is prohibited.

2. Library Ethics

- a. Students' library card will be treated as reading room card.
- b. At the time of entering the library every member shall be required Digital Attendance.
- c. All the personal belongings such as bag, other items etc. should be left at the property counter before entering the library.
- d. The reader must maintain silence within the library premises.
- e. No readers are allowed to sleep or gossip inside the library.
- f. The defaulter may be refused to the use of the library in future.
- g. Smoking and spitting inside the library are prohibited.

3. Social & Environmental Ethics

- a. Respect towards Principal, Vice-Principal, Head of the Departments, Librarian, Faculty, Office Staff and Auxiliary Staff.
- b. Mutual respect toward fellow students.
- c. All forms of ragging are strictly prohibited.
- d. Anti-social activities inside college campus are strictly prohibited.
- e. Consumption of drugs, liquor and tobacco in the college campus is strictly prohibited.
- f. Spiting on wall, notice board and banner is strictly prohibited.
- g. Throwing unused material in dustbin is expected.
- h. Anti institutional promotion is strictly prohibited.
- i. Any notice desired to be pasted or circulated by the students on the notice board or anywhere in the college shall require prior permission of the college authority.
- j. Harmful behaviour towards plants of college campus is strictly prohibited.

4. Ethics for ICT Tools Application

- a. Regular visit and checking updates on college website is expected.
- b. ICT tools of college shall not be used for any private or commercial purpose.
- c. Installing and using unlicensed or pirated software in computers of college is strictly prohibited.
- d. Gamming, watching objectionable photos and videos on computer and view board of college is strictly prohibited.
