The objectives of a student visit to a legislative assembly are to gain practical exposure to governance, understand the legislative process, and interact with officials, fostering a better comprehension of civic education and a sense of citizenship.


9. Programme Outcome:

The Department of Political Science organised Assembly Visit Programme on 10th January 2024. The programme was sponsored by the Government of Assam. For participation in the programme the department nominated 10 students from the department of Political Science who visited Assam Legislative Assembly on 10th January 2025. The students were guided by the local MLA, Sri Ajay Kumar Ray. The students saw firsthand functioning of the legislature, such as debates, discussions, and the process of making laws. They understood governance, learned how the state government, its leaders, and senior officials work. They got opportunity to interact with key figures like the Speaker and MLAs.

The students observed and learned about the entire process of how a bill is introduced, debated, and passed into law. They learnt about parliamentary democracy. The visit provided a practical, real-world view of parliamentary democracy in action, including the roles of the government and opposition parties. They gained exposure to elected officials. By attending a session, students could witness how debates take place, how "Zero Hour" and discussions are conducted, and how voting is done. The visit helped students connect concepts learned in subjects like political science, law, and public administration with the practical workings of government. This programme aimed to inspire students to become more engaged in civic duties and understand the importance of their role in a democratic society.

Learn about government structure: Students can learn about the seating hierarchy, the roles of different officials, and the physical layout of the assembly chamber.


