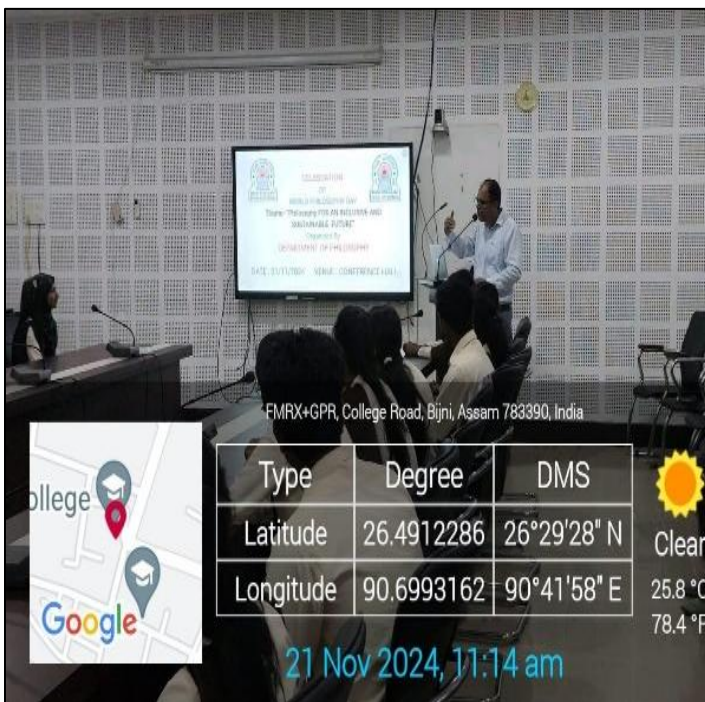
Description of the Event

The World Philosophy Day was celebrated by the department of philosophy on 21st November, 2024 at conference hall which was attended by 65 numbers of students.

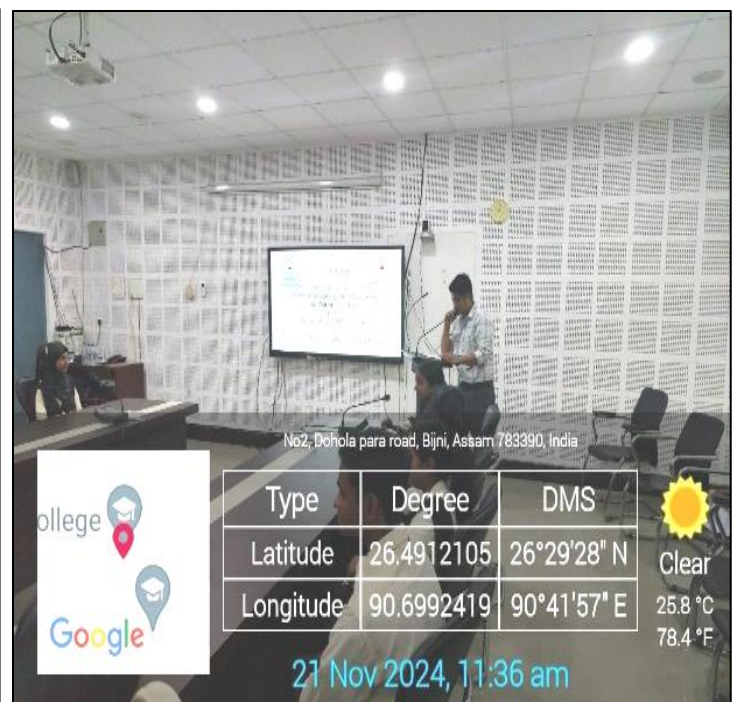

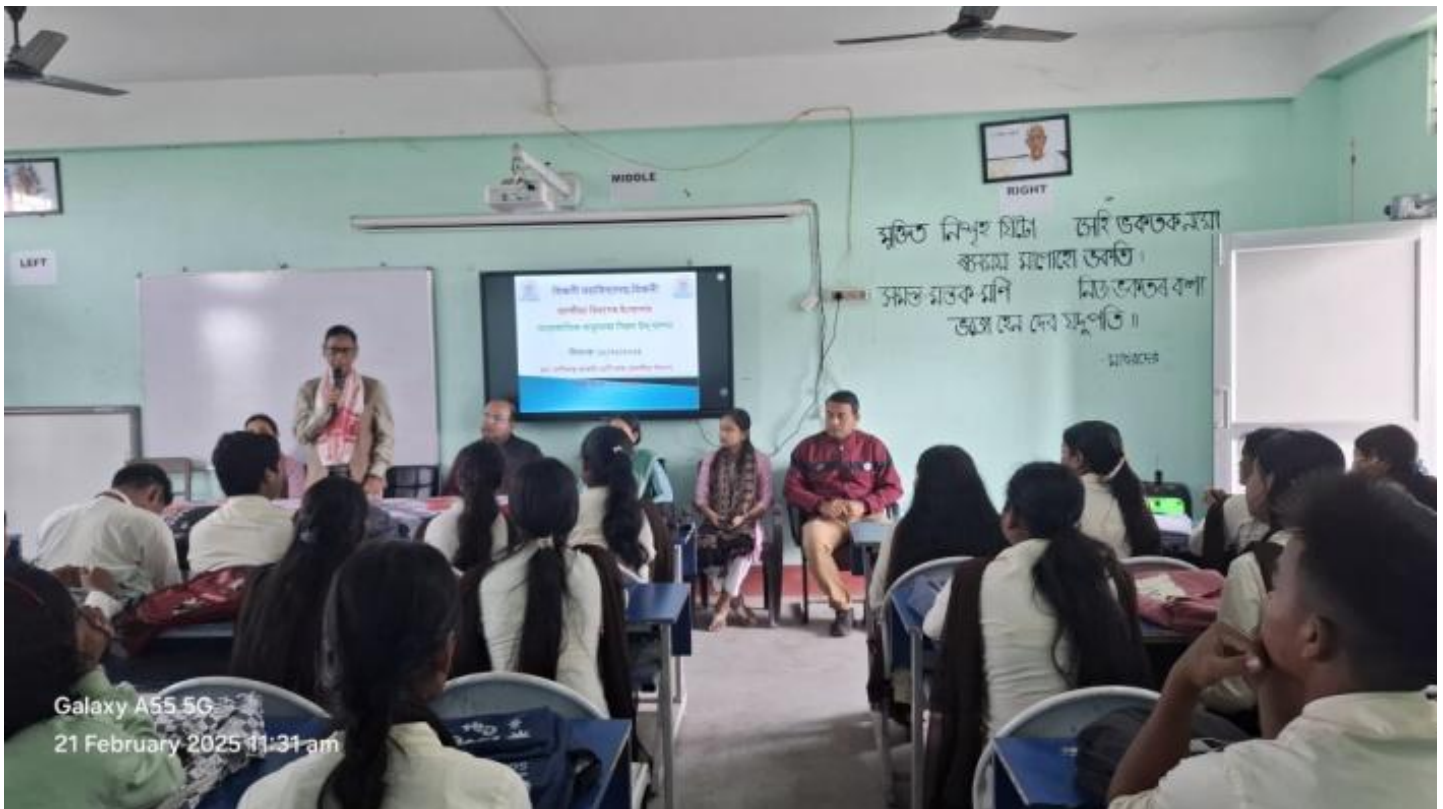

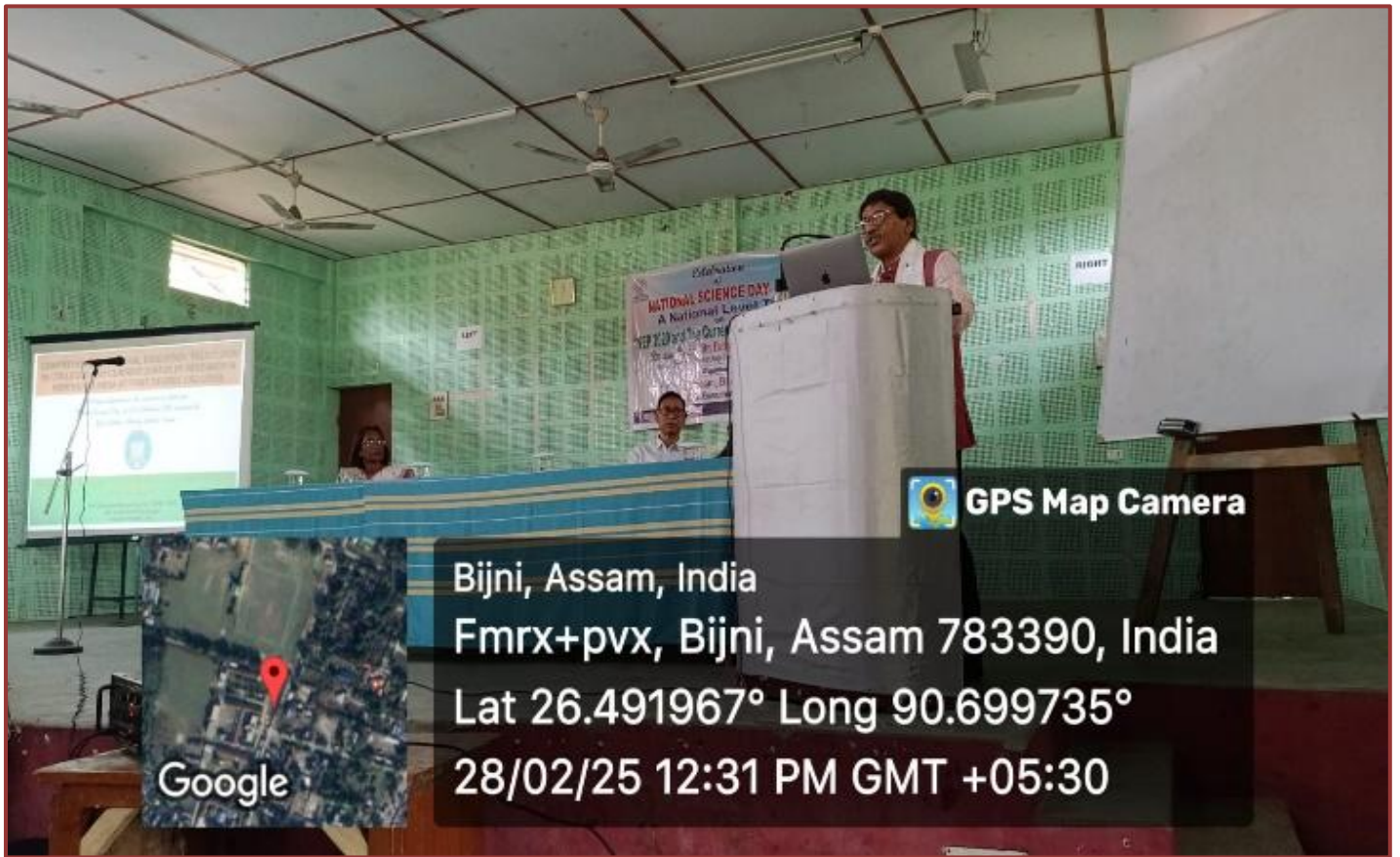

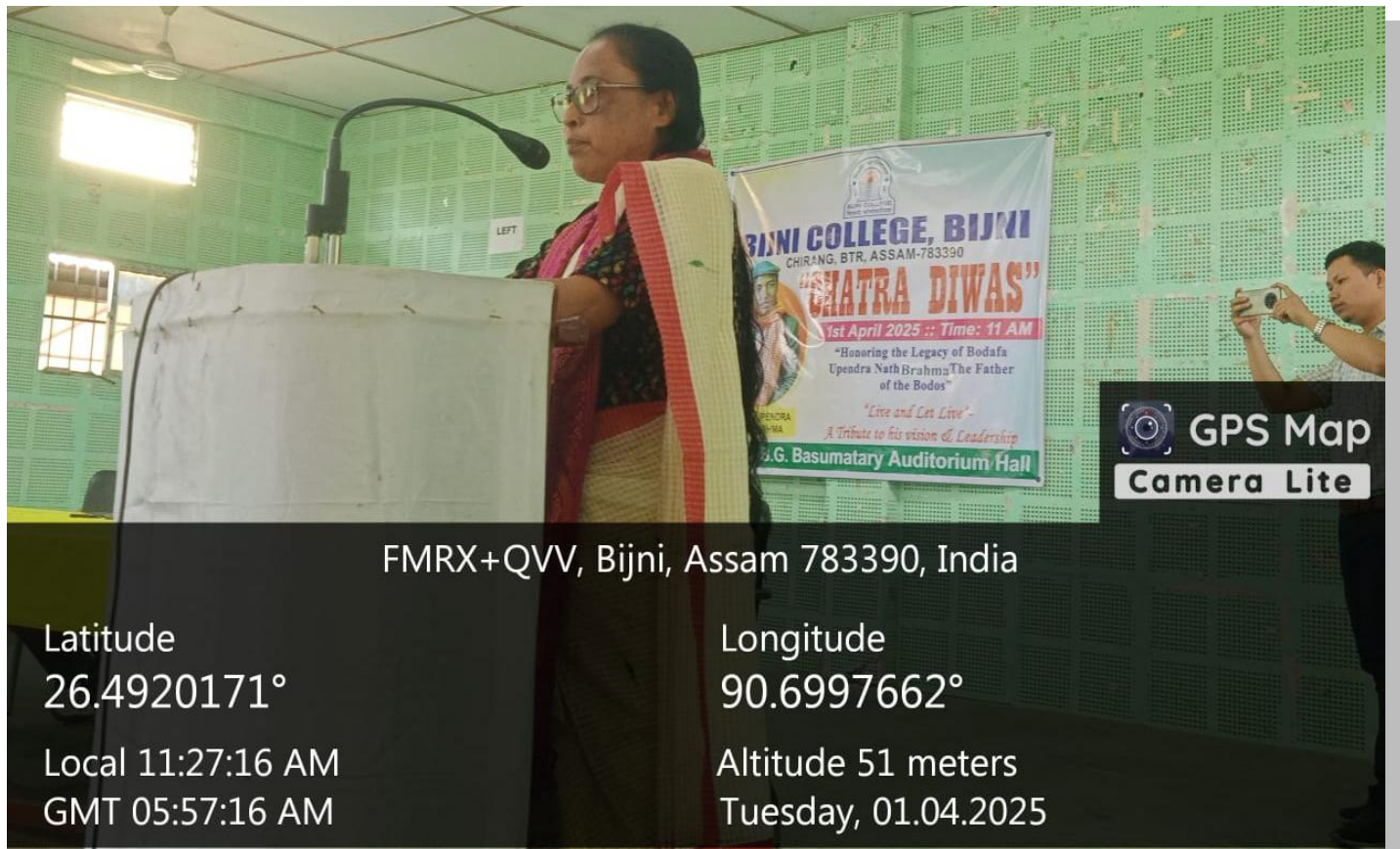
