About the College

Concept Note of Seminar

Cancer is one of the leading causes of death worldwide, accounting for nearly 10 million deaths annually. It is characterized by the uncontrolled growth and spread of abnormal cells, which can become life-threatening when they invade vital organs or metastasise to other parts of the body. According to the World Health Organization (WHO), lung, breast, colorectal, and prostate cancers are among the most common forms of cancer. Northeast India has witnessed a high incidence of cancer, with states such as Mizoram, Meghalaya, and Assam reporting alarming rates of lung, stomach, oesophageal, and gallbladder cancers. Factors such as tobacco consumption, dietary habits, lifestyle patterns, delayed diagnosis, and limited healthcare accessibility contribute significantly to the burden of the disease. Cancer treatment involves a combination of surgery, chemotherapy, radiation therapy, targeted therapy, immunotherapy, and, in some cases, traditional systems such as Ayurveda and folk medicine. Beyond its physical impact, cancer often creates severe psychological, social, and economic challenges for patients and their families. Awareness and early detection remain crucial for reducing cancer-related mortality. In this context, the seminar seeks to promote awareness, encourage research, and foster discussions on prevention, treatment, and policy interventions to address the growing cancer burden, particularly in Northeast India.

- **Abstract** should not exceed 300 words with 3 to 5 key words.
- The prescribed word limit for the **Full Paper** is 2500 to 3500 words.
- **Format:** The papers should be written in Microsoft Word in Times New Roman, 12 font size, Line spacing 1.5 and margin of 1 inch on each side.
- Reference should be in accordance with the APA format.
- Manuscript should contain the Title of the manuscript, Name with salutation, institution/ affiliation, e-mail ID, and contact number.
- The responsibility of any type of plagiarism found in any article will be borne by the author (s).
- Selected Papers will be considered for publication in a peer-reviewed national journal with ISSN.
- Further communication regarding publication will be done after the selection process.
