

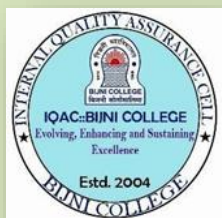

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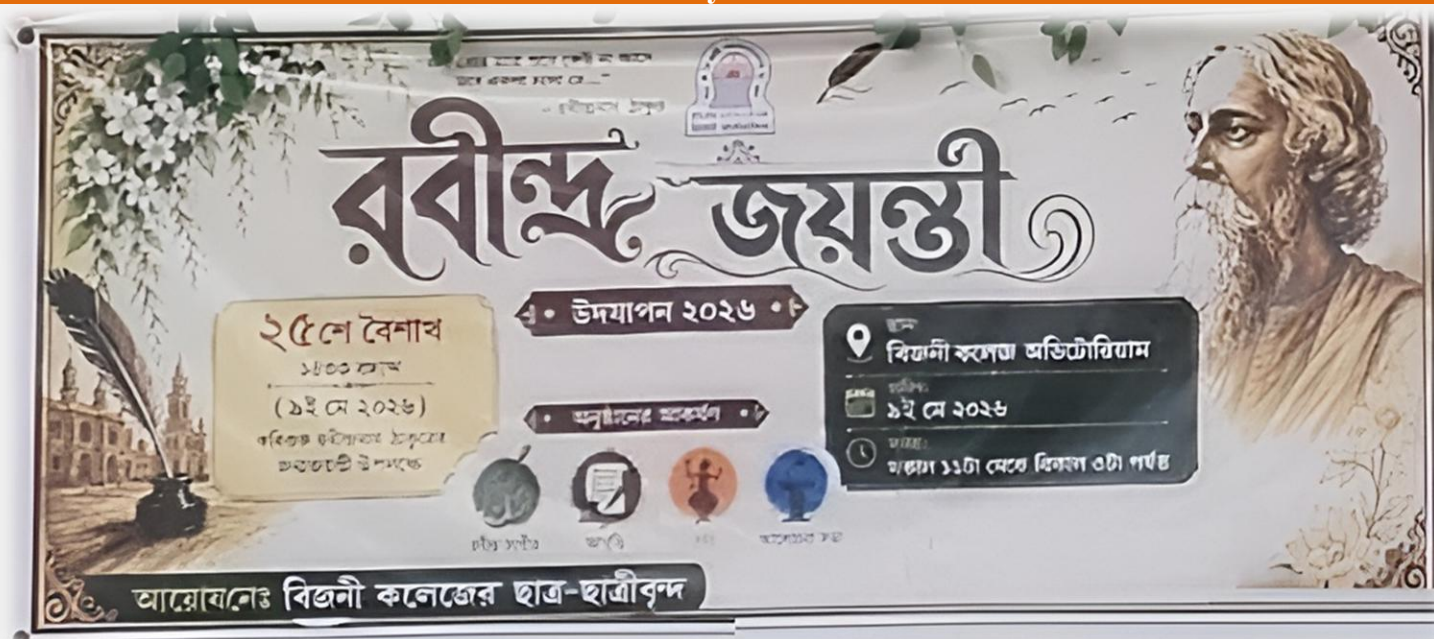

Programme Outcome

Popular talks on the life and philosophy of Rabindranath Tagore could foster spiritual humanism, promote intercultural understanding and encourage holistic, nature-based education. These talks by speakers and cultural demonstrators could inspire audiences by connecting Tagore's timeless ideals with modern societal challenges. From the talks attendees could be able to know about universal brotherhood and humanism. The talk could encourage participants to look beyond narrow nationalism and embrace a sense of unity among all cultures. The participants could be able to know the teaching compassion advocated by Tagore that service to man is service to God advocating for love and sacrifice over ego. The participants could also be able to understand the idea of NEP 2020 which is inspired by the advocacy of Tagore's Holistic Education that encourages creativity, highlighting his pedagogical vision that champions self-expression, artistic exploration and imagination over rote memorization. The participants also come to know how he harmonized teaching learning with nature by promoting his emphasis on outdoor, nature-based learning to develop a harmonious balance between mind, body, and soul. The participants could also be able to know the idea of fusion between spirit and culture. The talk also explores Tagore's spiritual writings how they help individuals connect their daily worldly duties with a broader cosmic reality. It also explores cultural heritage that needs preservation by celebrating the deep literary, musical, and artistic legacies of the Bengal Renaissance. From the talk of speakers, the participants become aware about eradicating social evils that Tagore felt in his time. He was in opposition to rigid caste discrimination and communal prejudices, and his focus on rural reconstruction and upliftment of the underprivileged. The talk also highlights the relevance of his idea and philosophy in the 21st Century. The talk explores how his socio-political insights offer viable frameworks for addressing modern issues such as materialism, environmental imbalance and cultural identity.

Proceeding of Workshop

The session began with introduction and felicitation of dignitaries by the organising committee led by students. It was followed by lighting of lamp by the principal. It was followed by welcome and keynote address by Dr. Dr. Birhash Giri Basumatary, Principal Bijni College who detailed overview of life and philosophy of Rabindranath Tagore. It was followed by speech from designated speaker, Sabita Ray, vice principal who basically highlights on the idea of humanism advocated by Tagore. It was followed by speech from designated speaker, Dr. Babul Basumatary, Co-ordinator, IQAC, Bijni College. He basically talked on the contribution of Tagore to the world and idea of Tagore on integration of tradition with modernism which should be the way of present life with humanist attitude. It was followed by speech from designated speaker, Dr. Arup Sarkar. He basically talked on the idea of Tagore on culture, education and humanism. He also highlighted how the NEP 2020 was inspired by the idea of Tagore in the field of education. It was followed by speech from resource person, Sanchayita Saha, Guest Faculty, Department of Bengali. She presented in a detailed way. She talked about the journey of Tagore's life from his birth to death, his creativity in literature, culture and philosophy of life. The session followed by poem recitation, cultural demonstration on song and dance institutionalized by Tagore. The students and faculty actively participated in the event.

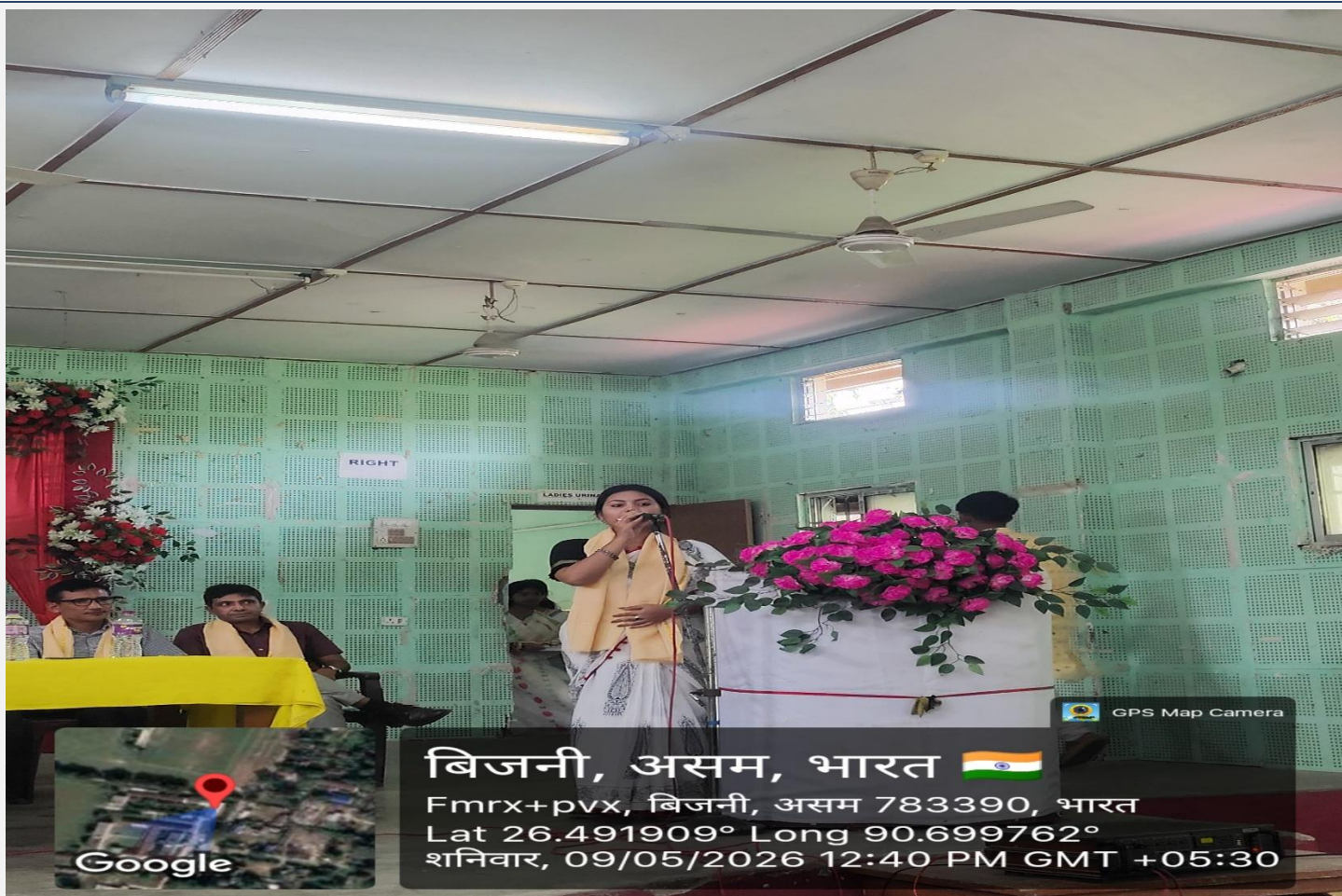

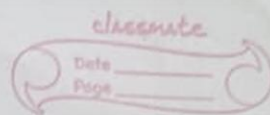

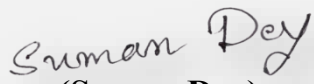
